**PLAN OF STUDY**

Students seeking a degree in the Barksdale Program must file a Plan of Study with an undergraduate advisor.

**ADMISSIONS**

**RESIDENCY**

The residency requirement is 32 hours. Residency may be completed anytime during the last half of degree requirements.

**ACADEMICS**

An earned 2.0 GPA overall is required for graduation. The grade of "C" or better is required in English 101, 102, and in all psychology classes. Bisc 101 and 102 may be substituted for Bisc 130 and 131.

**CLASSES**

Courses are offered in 12-week quarters. The unit of credit is the semester hour. Most evening classes meet one night a week from 5:30 to 9:15 p.m. Most daytime classes meet 60 minutes a day, four days a week.

**CREDIT THROUGH MILITARY EXPERIENCE\***

Louisiana Tech University accepts armed services specialized training and experience as recommended by the American Council on Education. To determine credit, Tech uses the *Guide to the Evaluation of Educational Experience in the Armed Services*, (the ACE Guide) published by the American Council on Education.

UNITED STATES AIR FORCE SERVICE of over one year counts for six semester hours of elective credit.

MILITARY SCHOOL credit is granted for those courses recommended by the ACE Guide.

CLEP SUBJECT EXAMINATION and DANTES SUBJECT STANDARDIZED TESTS (DSSTs) credits are granted as recommended in the ACE Guide.

\*The maximum allowable credit from these experiential sources is 60 semester hours. This credit is not computed in the academic grade point average.
